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### Q3 - What to Improve

Better communication about the sessions

Repetitive

The course should be kept to a shorter time as there is travelling required between campuses

More interactions with students

Case based discussions was long and repetitive

The course could definitely be shortened and could be done online to avoid long travel times between LEP's.

Perhaps more hands on experience

More activities in smaller groups

Greater depth would be better. It was very superficial and basic

Would prefer it to be shorter, felt a little repetitive

Nothing - the session covered everything a good amount of time

Break up the lectures with case studies inbetween, rather than all at once

The course was incredibly poor, started 30 minutes later than advertised and regurgitated the same content over and over. The delivery was lacklustre and the session would have had the same effect on a 30 minute teams call. Incredibly disappointing.

The first part of the course could have been done online or in a different Trust separately and the workshops could have been done in each Trust - communicating between 2 Trusts was very stressful

To do the course in each respective LEP

At the beginning it was a little random and not as organised in terms of timings set

Meeting on site was not necessary

A longer time for small group discussions

The examples were good, however doing the same exercise for 10 cases was a bit long.

The course was 60% longer than it needed to be, most of the useful information could have been presented in an hour or less and it was unnecessary for students to travel to Milton Keynes. The group work was not useful.

Many people did not know about this event. Proper notification in advance.

Location of the course.

Although the group aspect was nice, there were a lot of cases for the short amount of time we were given, and we were made to complete them all. I feel like the majority of the students had firmly grasped the concept of the exercise after a handful of cases.

Less repetition and perhaps just more interactive. Of course could be done online for those who have to travel. Complete waste, repeated some concepts over and over, unenthusiastic presentations, could have been held on a 30 minute teams call.
