Advanced pain training is provided by the Department of Anaesthesia based at Aberdeen Royal Infirmary. The pain trainee will rotate through the various sites of service delivery for training – Aberdeen Royal Infirmary (acute pain and theatres), Woodend Hospital (neuromodulation) and Aberdeen Community Health and care Village (Pain clinics including physiotherapist, psychology, psychiatry and PMP). All these sites are within radius of 3 miles with regular hospital shuttle bus services. Cancer pain is based at Roxburgh house, palliative care home. Pain MDT and educational meetings are held monthly.

Trainee has access to Addiction Medicine (Cornhill hospital), Paediatric chronic pain (Royal Aberdeen Children's Hospital), Rehabilitation Medicine (Woodend hospital) and neurology/headache clinics as well as MDTs (spinal pain, abdominal pain and urogynaecology) based at Aberdeen Royal Infirmary.
